The Fostering Kinship Care Legal Project

Many children in foster care actually live with older relatives in kinship care placements. Federal law now *requires* child welfare agencies to seek out possible relative caregivers within thirty days of a child entering the foster care system.

We provide free legal advice and representation to seniors during a time of immense family turmoil, assisting senior relatives as they take in and raise children at risk.
